# Age of first becoming a Grandparent

Results in this report are based upon questions asked in the UMR Research nation-wide omnibus survey. This is a telephone survey of a nationally representative sample of 750 New Zealanders 18 years of age and over.

Fieldwork was conducted in two consecutive surveys from the $4^{\text {th }}$ to $9^{\text {th }}$ June and the $18^{\text {th }}$ to $22^{\text {nd }}$ June 2009 at UMR Research's national interview facility in Auckland.

The questions were asked of respondents aged 35 and above. Across the two surveys the total sample size is $\mathrm{n}=1578$.

The margin of error for sample size of 1578 for a $50 \%$ figure at the ' $95 \%$ confidence level' is $\pm 2.5 \%$.

## Findings

- This research shows that the median age for becoming a grandparent is $45-49$, with the mode (the most common age) being 50-54.
$>$ This is slightly younger than the median age calculated from census statistics ( 53 for grandmothers and 56 for grandfathers)
$>$ Given that $51 \%$ became grandparents under the age of 50 and $47 \%$ became grandparents at 50 years of age or older (i.e. because the proportion who became grandparents before 50 is barely a majority), it is reasonable to assume that the true median is closer to 49 than to 45 .
- There was an apparent relationship between the age respondents became grandparents and both ethnicity and income.
$>53 \%$ of Maori respondents had become grandparents before the age of 45 years. The Pacific sample is too small for robust analysis.
$>37 \%$ of those with personal incomes of $\$ 15-\$ 40,000$ had become grandparents before the age of 45 years, compared with $27 \%$ of those with personal incomes above $\$ 40,000$ (the sample is not large enough to filter this by whether or not they were in paid work, so those with personal incomes below $\$ 15,000$ (who are often retired) are not compared here).
